

Summary of Purpose and Why:



**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 34, "CITY POLICY," OF THE POMPANO BEACH CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING SECTION 34.004, "FEES FOR PUBLIC RECORDS REQUESTS AND NOTARY SERVICE," TO PROVIDE FOR A FEE FOR THE CREATION OF A CD, DVD AND SIMILAR MEDIA; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, ten (10) days' notice has been given by publication in a paper of general circulation in the City, notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a public hearing in the City Commission Chambers of the City of Pompano Beach; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing before the City Commission was held pursuant to the published notice described above, at which hearing the parties in interest and all other citizens so desiring had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard; now, therefore,

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1.** That Section 34.004, "Fees for Public Records Requests and Notary Service," of the City of Pompano Beach Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

**§ 34.004 FEES FOR PUBLIC RECORDS REQUESTS AND NOTARY SERVICE.**

Copies of public records shall be furnished to any person, firm, corporation, partnership, organization or association upon the payment of the applicable fees as set forth below:

...

(F) A charge of \$10.00, ~~including the VHS tape,~~ shall be assessed for each created, duplicated or edited VHS tape-copy tapes, CD, DVD and similar media.

...

**SECTION 2.** If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage, and shall sunset six months from passage.
