SHORT TITLE Approval to purchase sports court resurfacing from Florida Courtworks, Inc. in the amount of \$15,273.60 per the School District of Palm Beach County Bid No. 07C-20A, from funds in CIP Project 09-985, and approval of accompanying budget adjustment.

Summary of Purpose and Why:

The Public Works Department requests approval to issue a Purchase Order to Florida Courtworks, Inc. to furnish and install acrylic coating to resurface sports courts at Avondale Park, McNab Park, and Community Park per the School District of Palm Beach County Bid No. 07C-20A. The resurfacing will extend the life of the basketball and tennis courts. The total cost of the resurfacing will be \$15,273.60. City Commission approval of this action, and the accompanying Budget Adjustment, is requested.

Subject: Concurrence, Resurfacing Sports Surfaces per the School District of Palm Beach County Contract No. 07C-20A

The Public Works Department recommends the City issue a Purchase Order to Florida Courtworks, Inc. to furnish and install acrylic coating to resurface sports courts at Avondale Park, McNab Park, and Community Park. The total cost for the resurfacing at all parks will be \$15,273.60. Florida Courtworks has quoted the projects to the City based on the School District of Palm Beach County "Term Contract to Furnish and Install Acrylic Coating for Sports Surfaces" contract #07C-20A. This contract is valid through January 31, 2011. Purchasing has confirmed Florida Courtworks was awarded this contract for the products quoted, and the pricing offered to the City is equal to the contract pricing. The court resurfacing will be purchased from account 302-7362-530.65-12, Capital Projects Fund / Project 09-985 Resurface Courts / Construction.

It is recommended that the Commission approve the purchase of court resurfacing per the Palm Beach Schools contract, from Florida Courtworks, Inc. Please see copies of the vendor's quotation, and applicable contract information, attached.



FINANCIAL IMPACT

The estimated annual financial impact to various budgets is \$ 50,000. The source of funds is various schools and departments budgets.

CONTRACT RENEWAL

Term Contract No. 07C-20A was awarded on January 30, 2007, to Florida Courtworks, Inc. for two years from February 1, 2007 through January 31, 2009 with the option to renew for three additional one-year periods.

The first option to renew was exercised from February 1, 2009 through January 31, 2010.

The second option to renew is now being exercised for the period February 1, 2010 through January 31, 2011.

Florida Courtworks, Inc. has agreed to honor terms, conditions and pricing of existing contract for the forthcoming contract period.

Items to be purchased include furnishing and installing acrylic coating for outdoor sports surfaces at school centers throughout the District.

RECOMMENDATION: Based on satisfactory performance during the past contract period, it is recommended that the Term Contract to Furnish and Install Acrylic Coating for Sports Surfaces be renewed with Florida Courtworks, Inc. for the period February 1, 2010 through January 31, 2011.
