

NOTICE OF ACCEPTANCE OF
APPLICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP ON
CITY OF POMPANO BEACH BOARDS AND COMMITTEES

The City of Pompano Beach is currently accepting applications for the following Boards and Committees:

Affordable Housing Advisory Board – Meets on call by the Director of Housing and Urban Improvement. The Board reviews the established policies and procedures, ordinances, land development regulations and adopted City comprehensive plan; to recommend specific actions or initiatives to encourage or facilitate affordable housing while protecting the ability of the property to appreciate in value.

Air Park Advisory Board - Meets the first Tuesday of each month at 5:30 p.m. The Board studies all operations of the Air Park, recommends capital improvements, etcetera.

Architectural Appearance Committee - Meets the second Thursday at 4:00 p.m. The Committee reviews specific projects to ascertain whether proposals would enhance the community or violate the spirit of Ordinance No. 98-57. The Committee also defines the objectives and determines whether the aesthetic intentions are actually embodied in proposed projects.

Budget Review Committee – Meets the first Tuesday of each month at 6:00 p.m. The Committee serves in an advisory capacity to the City Manager and City Commission and provides the City with input regarding the taxpayers' perspective in the development of the annual operating budget. The Committee also reviews projections and estimates from the City Manager regarding revenues and expenditures for the upcoming fiscal year; advises the City on service levels and priorities; and submits recommendations to the City Commission regarding the budget.

Charter Amendment Advisory Board - Meets the last Thursday of each month at 5:30 p.m., as business dictates. The Board advises the City Commission on the existing charter and makes recommendations for a perfect Charter.

Community Appearance Committee - Meets the third Thursday at 3:00 p.m. The Committee investigates, studies, makes recommendations to the City Commission for improvement of appearance and amenities, as well as undertakes and identifies other projects. The Committee also assumes other duties and responsibilities regarding appearance of the community.

Community Development Advisory Committee - Meets the second Thursday of each month at 7:00 p.m. The Committee serves as citizens' advisory body to the City Commission and makes recommendations on the adoption of an annual plan for community development projects.

Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) - Meets the fourth Tuesday of each month at 5:30 p.m. The Board conducts business and exercises the powers of the Agency as set forth in the Community Redevelopment Act.

East District CRA Advisory Committee - Meets the first Thursday of the month at 6:30 p.m. The Committee serves as advisory body to the Community Redevelopment Agency Board of Directors or staff regarding redevelopment in the East Community Redevelopment District.

West District CRA Advisory Committee - Meets the first Monday of the month at 6:00 p.m. The Committee serves as advisory body to the Community Redevelopment Agency Board of Directors or staff regarding redevelopment in the West Community Redevelopment District.

Cultural Arts Committee - Meets the third Tuesday of each month at 5:00 p.m. The Committee promotes and advocates the cultural arts within the City. The Committee also provides and finds a forum to seek grants and funding to develop and implement cultural arts programs; advocates for cultural arts, and undertakes such other duties, projects and responsibilities regarding the cultural arts within the City as may be assigned by the City Commission.

Education Advisory Committee - Meets the second Monday of each month at 3:30 p.m. The Committee acts in an advisory capacity to the City Commission and as liaison between the City and the School Board.

Emergency Medical Services Advisory Board - Meets the third Thursday of every odd month at 7:00 p.m. The Board advises the City Commission on all matters pertaining to providing Emergency Medical Services.

Employees' Board of Appeals - Meets on call by the Chairman. The Board hears and rules on appeals of disciplinary action against City Employees.

Employees' Health Insurance Committee - Meets on call by the Risk Manager. The Committee decides appeals from the denial of health insurance claims by the Claims Administrator.

General Employees' Retirement System - Meets the third Tuesday of each month at 1:30 p.m. The Board authorizes payments of benefits and disbursements from the fund.

Golf Advisory Board - Meets the third Wednesday of each month at 3:00 p.m. The Board reviews the operation of the Golf Course.

Historic Preservation Board – Meets the third Tuesday at 5:00 p.m. The Board creates and recommends historic districts and landmarks for the City; updates the official inventory of cultural resources; develops programs to stimulate public interest in urban neighborhood conservation and explores funding and grants sources. The Committee also cooperates with agencies of City, county, regional, state and federal governments in planning proposed historic preservation projects; approves or denies petitions for certificates of appropriateness required under the historic preservation

regulations; and assists in developing a historic preservation element to be incorporated into the City's Comprehensive Plan.

Housing Authority of Pompano Beach - Meets the third Wednesday of each month at 4:00 p.m. The Board administers Housing Authority.

Marine Advisory Board - Meets the third Monday of each month at 3:30 p.m. The Board makes recommendations on conditions of waterways, safety and traffic control, boat docking, service operation of City marinas, boat launching, etcetera.

Parks and Recreation Advisory Board - Meets the first Wednesday of each month at 4:30 p.m. The Board studies and makes recommendations on recreational needs and programs, and cultural activities within the City.

Planning and Zoning Board/Local Planning Agency - Meets the fourth Wednesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. The Board advises the City Commission in formulation of Master Plan; assists in the preparation of Official Maps; and reviews plats.

Police & Firefighters' Retirement System - Meets the third Monday of each month at 3:00 p.m. The Board determines questions relating to eligibility and participation, benefits; authorizes all payments and approves any and all changes.

Pompano Beach Economic Development Council - Meets the first Monday of each month at 5:15 p.m. The Board promotes economic development within the City of Pompano Beach.

Recycling and Solid Waste Committee - Meets the first Thursday of each month at 9:00 a.m. The Committee promotes and advocates recycling, solid waste reduction and reuse within the City, through programs implemented to encourage good waste management.

Sand and Spurs Stables Advisory Board - Meets the fourth Tuesday of each month at 1:00 p.m. The Board reviews operation of the Sand and Spurs Riding Stables.

Special Magistrate for Code Enforcement - Meets the second and fourth Wednesday of each month at 1:00 p.m. and the third Wednesday of each month at 2:00 p.m. The Magistrate hears code enforcement violation matters and assesses fines against violators of the City of Pompano Beach codes and ordinances.

Unsafe Structures and Housing Appeals Board/Nuisance Abatement Board - Meets the last Tuesday of each month at 5:00 p.m. The Board hears appeals of decision by the Building Official, orders compliance and hears appeals from the Minimum Housing Code.

Zoning Board of Appeals - Meets the third Thursday of each month at 6:00 p.m. The Board hears appeals and special exceptions and hardships, and issue variances from the Zoning Code.
