

# Guidelines and Information

The City of Pompano Beach would like to take this opportunity to inform you of the waste services provided to single family, duplex and triplex residential dwellings.

## 2011/12 Rate Structure

The monthly per residence or unit rate structure is:

Single Family House - \$19.92

Duplex Dwelling - \$19.33 per unit

Triplex Dwelling - \$18.76 per unit

The cost for waste services is included with the monthly water bill as a line item.

Note - The overall cost for multifamily depends on if complex is on curbside or dumpster service.

## Level of Service

Residents living in single family, duplex and triplex dwellings receive twice per week garbage service, once per week recycling and twice per week bulk services.

Vegetative trash should be placed with the household garbage for removal. Materials should be bagged, bundled or tied and should not exceed 4 foot length or 50 pounds.

Multifamily dwellings receive complementary bulk services twice per calendar year. The property manager or a member of the HOA Board of Directors should call 954-786-4030 to schedule this service.

## Garbage and Trash Reminders

Garbage should be placed into a container not to exceed 32 gallons in capacity and 60 pounds in weight. Containers should have a tight fitting lid. Heavy duty 32 gallon plastic bags not exceeding 30 pounds in weight may be used. Bags should be tied and placed to minimize rupture due to animals.

Items exceeding these limits will not be serviced.

## Recycling

Acceptable recyclable materials include - aluminum and tin cans; glass bottles and jars; plastic containers with the number 1, 2 or 3 on the bottom; magazines; phonebooks and newspapers.

Each residence is provided one 18 gallon bin for all recyclable materials.

## Bulk Waste Collection Guidelines

Only materials generated from the location will be removed. It is unlawful to bring materials from another location and place out for removal.

Materials do not include household hazardous waste, hazardous or special wastes, construction and demolition waste, vehicle parts, tires, electronics, or products containing glass which may break during collection.

Bulk waste items must be in such a size and/or quantity that does not allow for the materials to be containerized for normal garbage service.

Materials for removal should be placed off the roadway, on the front swale with the regular garbage and trash.

Place items away from power lines, fire hydrants, trees, fences or any other item that would impede collection of the material.

Do not place materials out for removal more than 24-hours prior to your collection day.

## Acceptable Bulk Items

Household goods - Appliances, furniture, mattresses, large toys, draperies and other miscellaneous materials that are normally found in a residential household.

Horticulture - Trimmings from bushes, shrubs and trees which do not exceed six feet in length. Materials must be in such a size and/or quantity that does not allow for the materials to be containerized for normal garbage service.

Building Materials - Wooden fence sections six feet or less in height and length, wooden doors, sinks, toilets, wood scraps, and other materials generated from MINOR building repair.

Miscellaneous - Cardboard boxes; empty cartons and other materials that are too large to be containerized for normal garbage service.

## General Rules

Appliances and horticulture materials must be placed in separate piles from other trash. This is to provide for alternate methods of disposal for these materials.

Materials for removal must be placed off the roadway on the front swale. Trucks will not go onto private property. Do not place trash on driveways because of possible damage by service equipment.

Any scheduled service that cannot be accomplished due to weather, mechanical breakdowns, etc., will be rescheduled for the next workday.

## Helpful Hints and Reminders

Holiday Schedule - Christmas Day is the only time waste services are suspended. If your service day falls on Christmas, it will be collected on the next regularly scheduled collection day. If you are an absentee owner, please pass this information on to your tenants.

Hazardous Materials - Items such as rechargeable batteries, house paints, computers, televisions, tires and other hazardous household wastes (i.e. cleaning solutions) cannot be collected at curbside.

Streetlights - To report a streetlight that is out, please call 954-786-4108. If possible, get the 11-digit number from the pole. If you are unable to find the number, have the address available. Streetlights on main roadways in Pompano Beach are maintained by the City.

Hurricane Preparedness - Prior to the storm, safely secure all your garbage cans, lids and recycling bins inside your garage or residence. After the storm, separate vegetative waste (trees and shrubs) from other bulky items (mattresses and furniture) and garbage. Normal garbage service will resume after the storm as soon as roads are accessible.

## Illegal Dumping

Illegal dumping is a crime. In fact it is a FELONY. Please report anyone illegal dumping by calling 911. Materials that are placed out for disposal must be generated from the property. It is illegal to bring materials from another location, even if you own both locations. Individuals that are caught illegal dumping will be arrested and their vehicles impounded. Remember... ILLEGAL DUMPING IS A CRIME!
