In the case of any premises where there is reuse water service for irrigation, there shall be no physical connection between the reuse water system and the customer's potable water system. An approved backflow prevention device shall be required at all premises that are served by reuse water on the water service at or near the point of delivery. Owners of backflow prevention devices shall have certified inspections and operational tests performed at least once per year and forward results to the Building Department. In those instances where the Utilities Director deems the hazard to be great enough, certified inspections may be required at more frequent intervals. The cost for inspection and testing shall be borne by the owner of the device and shall be performed by a certified backflow tester. The cost for the backflow preventer repair, overhaul, or replacement shall be borne by the owner of the device. Records of such tests, repairs and overhaul shall be kept and made available (copy provided) to the Building Department. Failure to perform tests within the stated period may result in the suspension of reuse or potable water service until such time as the necessary tests are conducted and accepted by the City of Pompano Beach. per City Ordinance Chapter 54
