

INTERGOVERNMENTAL COORDINATION  
GOALS, OBJECTIVES AND POLICIES

**Goal**

- 12.00.00 To provide for and participate in the coordination processes necessary and proper to ensure the delivery of quality municipal services, facilitate sound development, and maintain positive intergovernmental relationships.

**Objective**

- 12.01.00 Obtain and review the comprehensive plan elements from adjacent municipalities, and Broward County for consistency and compatibility with the City of Pompano Beach's Comprehensive Plan.

**Policies**

- 12.01.01 Request copies of adjacent municipalities' and Broward County's comprehensive plans as they become available.
- 12.01.02 Participate in cooperative exchanges of information regarding the Comprehensive Plan through the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) and the Technical Coordinating Committee (TCC) of the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO).
- 12.01.03 Through the Development Review Process, established as part of the land development regulations, applications for development in the City of Pompano Beach will be reviewed to determine the impacts on adjacent municipalities or unincorporated Broward County.
- 12.01.04 The City of Pompano Beach Local Planning Agency will notify municipalities and other property owners within 500 feet of a proposed Land Use Plan amendment or rezoning.

**Objective**

- 12.02.00 Actively coordinate the development of and subsequent amendments to the Future Land Use Element, the Recreation and Open Space Element, and the Capital Improvement Element with the five year plan of Broward County School Board.

**Policies**

- 12.02.01 Maintain direct contact with the School Board offices to keep informed of any changes in the five year plan.

- 12.02.02 Seek to enter into an interlocal agreement with the School Board to use the recreational portions of the school sites.

**Objective**

- 12.03.00 Participate in regular meetings of existing planning groups and agencies to exchange information and coordinate the adopted level of service standards with adjacent municipalities, Broward County, the South Florida region and the State of Florida.

**Policies**

- 12.03.01 Continue to send representatives of the City to the TCC and MPO meetings to discuss transportation planning.
- 12.03.02 Continue to send representatives of the City to the TAC meetings to discuss land use and planning issues including standards for the provision of recreation and open space.
- 12.03.03 Through the formal committee mechanism, provide required and requested information, regarding the implementation of the Pompano Beach Comprehensive Plan to the Broward County Planning Council, Office of Planning, South Florida Regional Planning Council, other municipalities and the public.
- 12.03.04 The City of Pompano Beach will notify the South Florida Regional Planning Council (SFRPC) of development proposals that may affect other local governments in the region, and if necessary utilize the SFRPC's informal mediation process to resolve conflicts with other local governments.

**Objective**

- 12.04.00 Continue the Interlocal Agreements regarding the provision of water and sewer services.

**Policies**

- 12.04.01 Continue the Large User Agreement with Broward County concerning the provisions of wastewater treatment.
- 12.04.02 Continue to supply potable water to the limited area in the City of Lighthouse Point and to the unincorporated area known as South Beach.
- 12.04.03 Continue the necessary agreements which allow certain portions of western Pompano Beach to receive potable water and sanitary sewer service from Broward County and City of Margate.

**Objective**

- 12.05.00 Cooperate and maintain an ongoing relationship with regulatory authorities, neighboring jurisdictions, Broward County and other groups which have interests in the coastal zone.

**Policies**

- 12.05.01 Participate with Florida Department of Natural Resources (FDNR) in their programs for regular beach renourishment and revegetation.
- 12.05.02 Participate in the contract with the U.S. Geological survey regarding the monitoring of salt water intrusion.
- 12.05.03 Participate in the hurricane evacuation plan as developed and administered by Broward County.
- 12.05.04 Coordinate with Hillsboro Inlet District the regular dredging of the Hillsboro Inlet.
- 12.05.05 Participate with the County, various state agencies and environmental groups in the protection and preservation of wildlife and their habitats through such programs as the Turtle Watch Program, manatee protection and the artificial reef program.

**Objective**

- 12.06.00 Develop and amend the City of Pompano Beach Future Land Use Plan within the framework of the Broward County Land Use Plan.

**Policies**

- 12.06.01 Submit amendments to the Broward County Planning Council according to their schedules.
- 12.06.02 Review proposed land use amendments, developments of regional impact and other development activities proposed in neighboring municipalities or unincorporated areas.

**Objective**

- 12.07.00 Cooperate with the County regarding potential annexation of unincorporated areas of Broward County.

**Policies**

- 12.07.01 Participate in all meetings proposing Countywide annexation plan.
- 12.07.02 Review all annexation proposals by adjoining municipalities.

**Objective**

12.08.00 Participate in transportation planning regarding future road improvements, bus scheduling, Tri-County Rail, bicycle facilities and airport expansion.

**Policies**

12.08.01 Participate in corridor studies with the County and the State to ensure that the concerns of the residents and businesses will be heard.

12.08.02 Attend TCC and MPO meetings to learn of proposed changes in the existing bus schedules.

12.08.03 Attend special meetings and participate in the Broward County's efforts to operate the Tri-County Commuter Rail.

12.08.04 Work with the Broward County bicycle coordinator, local groups and FDNR to improve the bicycle facilities in Pompano Beach.

12.08.05 Attend special meetings concerning the Ft. Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport and aircraft traffic in Broward County.

**Objective**

12.09.00 Insure that the City of Pompano Beach is adequately represented at all public meetings and on all committees which have items of concern to the City of Pompano Beach.

**Policies**

12.09.01 The City should strive to make appointments to all vacant committee positions within 60 days of vacancy.

12.09.02 Representative of the City who serve on committees shall attend the meetings and not be absent for more than 20% of the regular and special meetings.

12.09.03 Representatives of the City shall receive briefings concerning the City's interests and shall report back after the meeting.

12.09.04 The City shall send representatives to all public meetings to protect the City's interests.
