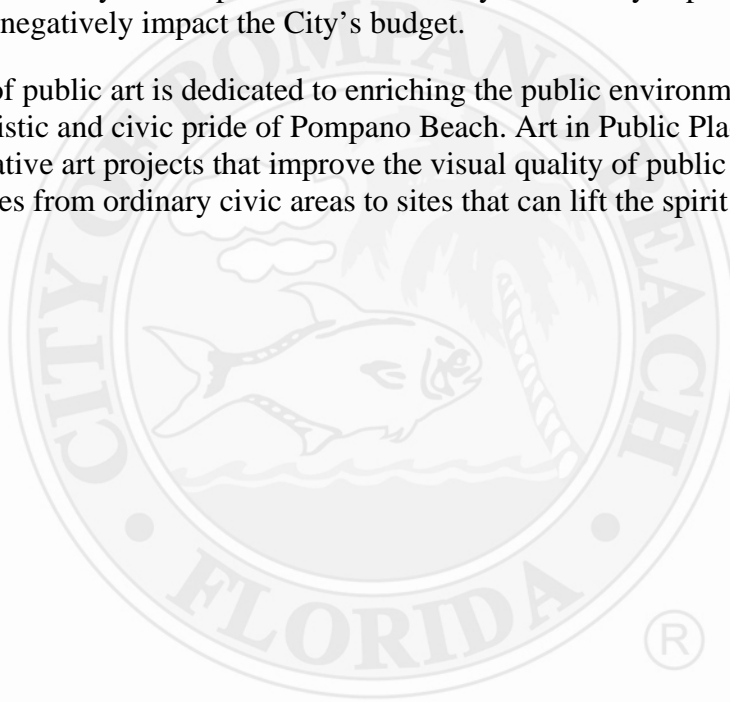

City Commission Approves Public Art Concept

The Pompano Beach City Commission recently voted to accept the concept of a public art program. City Manager Keith Chadwell and volunteer coordinator Bill Venz have been meeting with several neighboring cities that have already developed successful programs to use as models in structuring a public art program for the City of Pompano Beach. The City is currently exploring ways to fund the program that will not negatively impact the City's budget.

The implementation of public art is dedicated to enriching the public environment and to preserving and enhancing the artistic and civic pride of Pompano Beach. Art in Public Places promotes collaboration and creative art projects that improve the visual quality of public spaces. The goal is to transform public spaces from ordinary civic areas to sites that can lift the spirit and improve the quality of life experience.
