The four city manager candidates will make a 15 minute presentation on what they feel are the top issues facing the City of Pompano Beach. The four candidates are:

- **Dennis Beach**, who served as the City Manager in Ft. Pierce, Florida for over thirteen years, the Assistant City Manager in Port St. Lucie and City Manager in three Oklahoma cities.
- **T.C. Broadnax**, who served as Assistant and Deputy City Manager in Pompano Beach. Mr. Broadnax is currently one of the Assistant City Managers in San Antonio, Texas.
- **Gary Shimun**, currently Town Administrator in Davie and former Assistant City Manager in Pembroke Pines, Florida. Mr. Shimun has served as City Manager in Hannibal, Missouri; McCall, Idaho and Iron River, Michigan.
- **James Twombly**, who recently left his position as City Manager of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma and is the former City Administrator of Pella, Iowa. Mr. Twombly also held a variety of positions with Oklahoma City and is currently working with the City of Tulsa while he is in transition.
