This tax increment is used to finance the redevelopment projects outlined in the Community Redevelopment Plan.

The Pompano Beach East CRA consists of 158 acres from NE 18 Avenue east to the Atlantic Ocean around the east Atlantic Boulevard corridor. It was created in order to make strategic investments to create economic opportunity and improve the quality of life for the people who live and work in the community.
