Attention contractors and developers! The City of Pompano Beach Office of Housing and Urban Improvement is offering Renovate Right Pamphlet (RRP) Rule Certification Training. Effective April 22nd, the EPA will require any residential contractor that disturbs 6 sq ft or more of any interior painted surface or 20 square feet or more of any exterior painted surface on any residential home or child occupied facility, to become a "Certified Renovator."

To become a "Certified Renovator" you must complete one of two training courses that have been designed by the EPA. The first option is an eight hour course for those with no previous Lead Based Paint training. The second option is a 4 hour refresher course that was designed for those with proof of successful completion of an approved EPA or HUD renovation or abatement course.

The City's Office of Housing and Urban Improvement is hosting two of the eight hour training courses on March 15th or March 16th. Contractors, developers and other HUD program related employees are invited to register for this training which implements the Lead Safe Housing Rule in HUD Funded Programs Course.

These courses are approved by HUD and satisfy the Lead Safe Housing Rule's Lead Safe Work Practice requirements, but this is not an Abatement Course. This course was designed for home renovators to teach them how to determine if they are working with Lead Based Paint, how to contain the work area and how to clean it up safely.
