## Northwest CRA Workshops Monday, March 29<sup>th</sup> Wednesday, March 31<sup>st</sup> Monday, April 5<sup>th</sup>

The Pompano Beach Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) will host a series of workshops to inform residents of planned projects for the NW Pompano Beach area. The workshops will focus on a multi-family affordable housing project, tot lot, bus shelters, office/retail development, and beautification/streetscape projects.

The Workshops are scheduled for Monday, March 29<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 p.m. at the Jan Moran Collier City Learning Library which is located at 2800 N.W. 9<sup>th</sup> Court; Wednesday, March 31<sup>st</sup> at 7:00 p.m. at the Jan Moran Collier City Learning Library and Monday, April 5<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m. at the E. Pat Larkins Center which is located at 520 Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard. Each Workshop will include several workstations. Each workstation will focus on a specific project and allow participants to provide input regarding the project.

“We are very excited about the redevelopment projects planned for the Northwest section of our city,” NW CRA Director Floyd Johnson said. “The projects will help bring more vitality to the area and address quality of life issues such as affordable housing, jobs and safe spaces like parks and libraries. We want to provide residents with a detailed look at each project and then encourage immediate input on the proposed plans for implementation,” Johnson explained. “So, it is very important that residents attend the workshop and find out about redevelopment planned for their communities.”
