Disaster Recovery Program Funds Available

The City of Pompano Beach Office of Housing and Urban Improvement is now accepting applications for the Disaster Recovery Initiatives Program providing disaster relief mitigation financial assistance.

The Disaster Recovery Program was designed to provide a one-time disaster mitigation repair assistance grant up to a maximum of \$15,000 to improve the housing and living conditions of eligible low-income families. It is not a remodeling program. The Community Development Block Grant funds will be used for wind mitigation improvements including storm shutters, windows, doors, and roof replacement including wind mitigation enhancements in compliance with the Florida Building Code. The program is designed for housing quality standards and health and safety needs. The program provides assistance to single-family detached homes depending on the eligible needs of the property. Life of estates and mobile homes are not eligible.

The target beneficiaries of the Disaster Recovery Program are elderly, disabled, and low-income families living within the city limits of Pompano Beach. Verification of income and proof of home ownership are required for the program.

Household income cannot exceed 80% of median family income. Income eligibility by household size:
