The cost for the Seafood Festival is \$10.00 per person per day. Children under 10 are free. The hours are Friday, April 16<sup>th</sup> 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m., Saturday, April 17<sup>th</sup> 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. and Sunday, April 18<sup>th</sup> 11:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Free trolley service runs from the parking lots at both Wachovia and Washington Mutual Banks, both located approximately three blocks east of U.S. 1 on Atlantic Boulevard. There is paid parking at the municipal lots on the beach across from the Pompano Fishing Pier. There is also paid parking available in a number of private lots around the beach.

**Due to construction on the Atlantic Boulevard Bridge which is reduced down to one lane east bound and road closures, it is strongly recommended that traffic take 14<sup>th</sup> Street Causeway (north of Atlantic Boulevard) east to A1A, then head south to get to the Seafood Festival.**

Road closures will begin at 7:00 a.m. Friday, April 16<sup>th</sup> through Monday, April 19<sup>th</sup> at noon on Atlantic Boulevard. from A1A east to the beach, Pompano Beach Boulevard from N.E. 2nd Street South to Atlantic Boulevard and Briney Avenue from S.E. 2nd Street north to Atlantic Boulevard.
