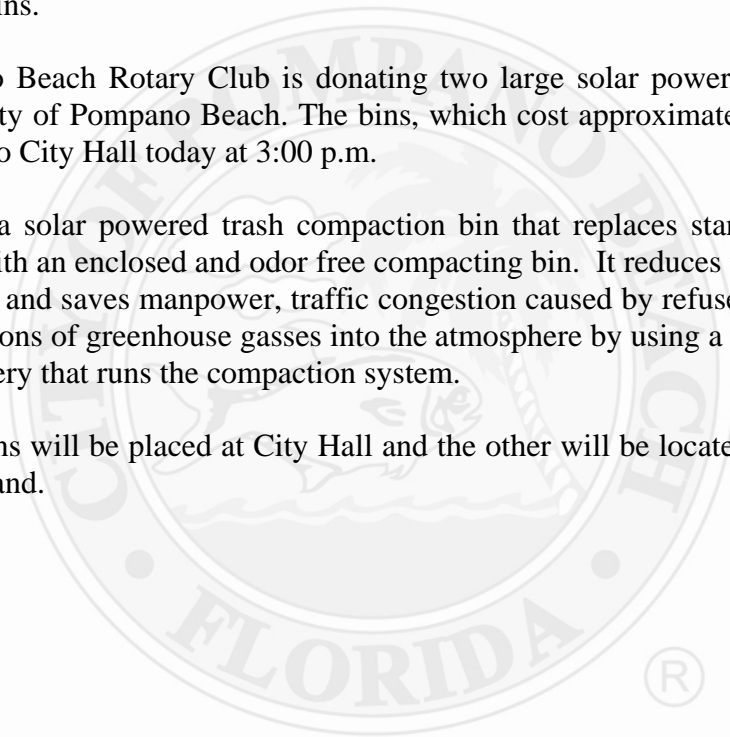

The City of Pompano Beach is going green with two new Big Belly solar powered trash compaction bins.

The Pompano Beach Rotary Club is donating two large solar powered trash compaction bins to the City of Pompano Beach. The bins, which cost approximately \$4,000 each, will be delivered to City Hall today at 3:00 p.m.

Big Belly is a solar powered trash compaction bin that replaces standard outdoor waste receptacles with an enclosed and odor free compacting bin. It reduces the need for frequent trash removal and saves manpower, traffic congestion caused by refuse trucks, fuel and the related emissions of greenhouse gasses into the atmosphere by using a solar panel to charge a 12-volt battery that runs the compaction system.

One of the bins will be placed at City Hall and the other will be located at the Fishing Pier concession stand.
