Water Conservation Kit Program

The City of Pompano Beach Utilities Department has received a Water Savings Incentive Program Grant from the South Florida Water Management District to fund up to 50% of a residential conservation retrofit program. The City will give away 2,000 kits containing a low flow shower head, bathroom aerator and kitchen aerator to potable water residential customers served by the City of Pompano Beach Utilities Department. This program is expected to save 56 million gallons of potable water per year.

Mailers have been sent to 14,000 residential customers with information about the free kits including a business reply postcard to request a kit. Residents living in condominiums are eligible. The kits will be shipped with a label on the box identifying the program. Residential water customers can also go to the City's website at www.mypompanobeach.org to sign up for a kit. The City is giving away one kit per household while supplies last.
