Bring the whole family to see full-length feature films projected onto a giant inflatable 25 foot outdoor movie screen at the Four Fields Complex located at 1700 NE 8th Street. All movies will begin at dusk which at approximately 8:30 pm. Due to anticipated crowd size, AVATAR will be shown at the Pompano Beach Amphitheater 1801 N.E. 6 Street.

Like the City of Pompano Beach's popular Music Under the Stars, this event is for all ages and is FREE. Patrons are encouraged to bring chairs, blankets, food, and drinks to enjoy during the movie.

The movie schedule for Movie Under the Stars:

July 10th - "Marley and Me" - Heel the love...A family learns important life lessons from their adorable, but naughty and neurotic dog. (Rated PG)

July 24th - "Night at the Museum, Battle of the Smithsonian" - In addition to Ben Stiller, the cast will be rounded out by many from the original film as well as several new characters from history. The centerpiece of the film will be bringing to life the Smithsonian Institution, which houses the world's largest museum complex with more than 136 million items in its collections, ranging from the plane Amelia Earhart flew on her nonstop solo flight across the Atlantic and Al Capone's rap sheet and mug shot to Dorothy's ruby red slippers and Archie Bunker's lounge chair. No major film has ever shot inside the Smithsonian in Washington... until Night at the Museum: Battle of the Smithsonian. (Rated PG)

August 6th - "The Sandlot" - A comedy about a summer of friendship and adventure during which one boy becomes part of a team. Nine boys become best friends and their leader becomes a legend by confronting the terrifying mystery beyond the left field fence. Ruff! Ruff! (Rated PG)

September 3rd - "AVATAR" ****Due to anticipated crowd size, AVATAR will be shown at the Pompano Beach Amphitheater 1801 N.E. 6 Street**** - Runaway box office hit! Avatar is the story of an ex-Marine who finds himself thrust into hostilities on an alien planet filled with exotic life forms. As an Avatar, a human mind in an alien body, he finds himself torn between two worlds, in a desperate fight for his own survival and that of the indigenous people. (Rated PG-13)
