Code Enforcement Lien Amnesty Program Extended August 19th, 2010 through February 19, 2011

The City of Pompano Beach City Commission has extended the Code Enforcement Lien Amnesty Program to provide property owners an opportunity to resolve outstanding Code Enforcement liens against their properties at a substantial discount. The Code Enforcement Amnesty Program discount is 25% of the lien's face value or \$1,000, whichever is less.

The Code Enforcement Lien Amnesty Program extension will be in effect from August 19, 2010 until February 19, 2011. Log on to the City's web site at <http://www.mypompanobeach.org/directory/index.html#code> and review the Code Enforcement Amnesty Program information. After taking steps to ensure your property is compliant with all previously issued Code violations, you can complete the Code Enforcement Lien Amnesty Program Participation Agreement also found on the City's web site and submit it to the Special Magistrate Clerk who will arrange an inspection of your property to confirm compliance. Forms and information can also be obtained by visiting the Special Magistrate Office on the 4th floor of City Hall.

The Amnesty Program is an effort to bring more properties in compliance which will help the City continue to maintain its neighborhoods, protect property values and preserve quality of life for its residents.
